

Be creative...

Simple Lace Scarf



Right side rows



Wrong side rows

Materials: 100g James Brett Stonewash DK (290m), 4mm knitting needles, yarn needle for weaving in ends.

You can substitute any DK yarn; the scarf will need 100-200g depending on the yarn, the length you want to make your scarf and any tassels or fringing you want to add.

Cast on 33 stitches

Row 1: knit 1*yo, knit 2 together, purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * to end of row

Row 2: purl 1 *yo purl 2 together, knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * to end of row

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until scarf is the length you want; our sample is approximately 150cm long and we still had some yarn left over (even after adding a fringe).

Cast off – make sure you don't pull your stitches too tight when casting off.

To finish: weave in ends. You can add a fringe or tassels, or gather the ends and sew on pompoms from the yarn you have left.

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
