Great for blankets, scarves, cushion covers and other accessories, and this technique produces stunning effects from striped and variegated yarns – or just from your scraps!</p>

If you have spotted something you really want to make you are welcome to bring your own pattern and we will get you going.</p>

Our sample in the shop is one of our most admired pieces.</p>
29 September 2018	<p>Granny Squares and More</p> <p>Everyone recognises the Granny Square pattern, and even beginners can quickly become confident in working it. However if you want a challenge, we will also have patterns and samples for circles, stars and more to get you looking at this old favourite in a new way. Why not try some Granny-style crocheted coasters, or a cute bunny motif?</p>
6 October 2018	<p>Beginners Crochet</p> <p>A workshop is for complete beginners or anyone who wants a refresher on the basics. We work at your own pace; most people can work chain, double and treble stitches by the end of a session and those with more experience usually go on to work some shaping or simple patterns. 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	<p>your crochet, this is for you – more challenging than a Granny Square (at least at first!) but easier than Bavarian crochet, you will learn how to work post stitches and gain confidence with pattern reading.</p>

24 November 2018	Tunisian Crochet An interesting technique, sometimes described as the look of knitting achieved with a (long!) crochet hook – there is nothing quite like Tunisian crochet. It is simple to learn the basic stitches, and produces a distinctive, thick fabric which is great for bags and home accessories. We will have Tunisian hooks available to borrow on the day so you can try it out and decide if this technique is for you!
